

# SAVE OUR LANES

City Council has voted to remove the Jarvis bike lanes without consulting the community or local City Councillor and against the advice of City staff.

The reinstatement of the centre lane will cost hundreds of thousands of dollars - a Gravy Lane.

Removing the bike lanes may make traffic worse for drivers by adding hundreds of bikes to the right hand lanes - which are now just for cars.

Jarvis Street is currently working for everyone: over 1,000 cyclists daily depend on the bike lanes for safety and the lanes act as a buffer between cars and pedestrians.
